

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 07

AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE CITY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (CPOC)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 mandates all local government units to organize the Peace and Order Council pursuant to Executive Order No. 309, Series of 1998, as amended with the same composition and function enumerated therein.

WHEREAS, Presidential Executive Order No. 309, Series of 1988, as amended by Presidential Executive Order No. 729, Series of 2008, reorganizing the Peace and Order Council, was established to carry out all programs of the government related to public order and security.

WHEREAS, on January 5, 2009, the Peace and Order Council was further reorganized by President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo by virtue of Executive Order No. 773, Series of 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALEX L. ADVINCULA, Mayor, City of Imus, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order to reorganize the City Peace and Order Council (CPOC):

Section 2. Duties And Functions- The Council's activities shall include, to the extent permitted by laws, as follows:

- a. Providing a forum for dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
- b. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety, including anti-insurgency measures;
- c. Recommend measures to converge and orchestrate internal security operations efforts of civil authorities, agencies, military, and police;
- d. Apply moral situation to and/or recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to communist rebels;
- e. Monitor provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects and isolate them from Communist Rebels who agitate/arouse, organize, and mobilize an ideological, political, and organization works;
- f. Perform other functions assigned by law, the President, or the National Peace and Order Council (NPOC).

Section 3. Peace and Order Council Secretariat-

There shall be a CPOC Secretariat which shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the Peace and Order that is organized in the various administrative levels of government. The Secretariat shall also undertake listing and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government.
